## GULF REGION BOAT OF THE YEAR NOTICE OF SERIES 2024 - 2025

- 1. Organizing authority: The organizing authority shall be the club hosting the event.
- 2. Eligibility: The Boat of the Year series is open to all WFPHRF members. There is no registration or fee required. Any boat competing in a Boat of the Year regatta is automatically included in competition for Boat of the Year.
- 3. Class Breaks: The primary groups covered by this Notice of Series are Spinnaker, Non Spinnaker, Racer-Cruiser and Cruiser.
- 4. Divisions: There must be three boats to constitute a division. If a competitor does not have sufficient boats in his class to constitute a division, it will be placed in an appropriate division for that regatta. His score in that regatta will be applied to his position in his class in the BOTY series.
- 5. Scoring: This series will be scored on the Traditional High Point Scoring System.

In order to qualify for awards in this series, a competitor must race at least 60% or 3 of the 5 races in the series.

All boats properly entered and checked in with the race committee at the start of a race in a regatta will receive 5 participation points. The boat's score will be her overall assigned fleet position for her class/division at the end of the regatta.

THE TOTAL SCORE FOR THE SERIES will be the sum of the boat's best scores in 3 of the 5 races in the series. If more races are entered, the three best scores will count with the worst score being "thrown out".

Points for DNF and DNS will equal 1 point.

Points for DSQ and DNC will equal 0.

Ties will be broken at the end of the series and all regattas will be included. DOUBLE POINT REGATTA: Double points will be given for any regatta that is a one day event. If more than one race is held in that day, the boat's overall finish for the day will be used. It will count as one regatta for qualification in the series and participation points.

Individual race scores within a regatta will be scored as follows:

US Sailing example defines "N" to be the number of boats that compete in a race in the same class. Each boat finishing that race and not hereafter retiring or being disqualified will be scored as follows, using an example of 20 boats in a class. (The boat essentially receives their placement plus the number of boats they beat in that regatta).

6. Trophies: The number of trophies for each class/division will be based upon the the number of boats qualifying for the series, having sailed at least 3 of the 5 Boat of the Year regattas.
